### Guidance Notes

Regulation 13(2) of The First-tier Tribunal for Scotland General Regulatory Chamber Parking and Bus Lane Appeals (Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2020 as amended by The First-tier Tribunal for Scotland General Regulatory Chamber and Upper Tribunal for Scotland (Composition and Rules of Procedure) (Miscellaneous Amendment) Regulations 2023 provides that a hearing must be held in public unless the First-tier Tribunal, on its own initiative or on an application by an appellant, decides that it is necessary to do otherwise to ensure a fair hearing.
